**Belgrade became the world center of night life.** British "Guardian" ranked it as number one in South East Europe when it comes to clubbing. After day tours we recommend relaxation in "Belgrade way", stroll the illuminated downtown streets, have a drink in one of the numerous cafés and pubs located literally everywhere. Then you can taste delicious food in a Serbian national restaurant in bohemian street of Skadarlija and feel the spirit of the 19 th century. You can complete your night-out by touching of glasses in a night club, discotheque, wine and rakia bars, or casino - and all that at low prices. Every night - and not only weekends - Belgrade hosts a huge variety of clubs and parties, especially in urban bohemian Strahinjica Bana street (known as "Silicone Valley") and in other parts of the old city center, such as "Dorcol" and "Obilicev Venac" square. You can also dance in the old Belgrade Fortress and cocktail bars, in underground caverns and on boats or raft boats - Belgrade's particular attraction.

**There is a great diversity of tourist services on the banks of the Danube and the Sava rivers, and Belgrade Lake - Ada Ciganlija resort.** Sitting at restaurant gardens, at clubs and cafés on the river, one can enjoy the reflection of more than 200 rafts and boats and their most dynamic parties. There is a whole range of music styles to dance to: from electronic, jazz & blues, drum'n'bass, hip-hop, r'n'b, techno, pop and rock, heavy metal, Gypsy and Serbian folk music, and more. The offer on the river banks is completed by Belgrade Lake - Ada Ciganlija resort, a favorite picnic area of Belgrade, 4 km from the center, with more than 50 restaurants, clubs and cafés around the lake.

Concerts of famous music stars, various music, theater and film festivals are organized in Belgrade almost each week, and summer **"BEER FEST"**, attracting hundreds of thousands of people, became a recognizable city brand. Vicinity of Novi Sad, the second largest city in Serbia, with intensive nightlife and world-known **"EXIT FESTIVAL"** renders the offer complete.

If the night life ends at early morning hours, one should still consider the next day and excursions and sensations that are still to come.



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
