

Dynamic sightseeing - the best way to discover Belgrade

BELGRADE PANORAMA

Approximately 2 hrs

Standard panoramic sightseeing by coach or bus. The program presents various city quarters, New Belgrade on the left side of the Sava river, Belgrade Fortress, the luxurious residential area of Dedinje and the picturesque old town. On the way one will pass by St. Sava temple, Slavija Square, Belgrade Palace, the "New Court", City Hall, the State Parliament, Terazije and Freedom Squares (central town squares), the National Theatre and Museum, Belgrade University and more.

BELGRADE PROMENADE

Approximately 3 hrs

Walking tour of Belgrade heritage. Starts with visit to the Belgrade Fortress with spectacular panoramic view on the Sava and the Danube confluence, Kalemegdan park, its upper town area (artillery structures and medieval ramparts with excavation of the castle) and one of its two churches, the Old Town, where you will see some of the most beautiful monuments, mansions and palaces from the 19th century, including the oldest restaurant in Belgrade "Question mark" built in 1823, the princess Ljubica's residence and the Orthodox Cathedral church, Belgrade Palace, the "New Court", City Hall, the State Parliament, the National Theatre and Museum, Belgrade University, the main pedestrian zone of Knez Mihailova street and much more.

SIGHTSEEING FROM RIVER - BY BOAT OR SPEEDBOAT

Approximately 2 hrs

Explore the Danube and the Sava river; Zemun with Gardos tower, confluence of two rivers, the Great War Island, Lido Beach, Belgrade Fortress, Belgrade old town and panorama, numerous clubs on rafts and boats, Belgrade Lake, Ada Medjica island, and much more.

SIGHTSEEING FROM HOT AIR BALLOON

60-90 minutes,

Includes balloon flight, diploma, celebration on the landing spot with sparkling wine, insurance. Flying is possible every day in the year when there is no rain, snow or strong wind. The balloon flies up to 1,000m high with up to 5 passengers.

SIGHTSEEING FROM SMALL AIR PLANE

Approximately 25 minutes

Sightseeing of all the neighborhoods of the city and its surroundings. An excellent way to see wider picture of Belgrade.

BELGRADE UNDERGROUND

Approximately 3 hrs

Tour shows some of the underground tunnels and caves of the old town, Tasmajdan Park and Belgrade Fortress which date back to the Neolithic, Celtic and Roman period, through Turkish, Austro-Hungarian, Serbian and German complex of secret tunnels connected with caves and basements.

BELGRADE WINE TOUR

Approximately 2 hrs

Includes wine degustation in modern wine bar and visit to rustic underground wine cellar, and represents the history of wine that has been produced in this region since the 3rd century, with reference to the cult of wine in the world and the history of production of this noble beverage.

BOHEMIAN - RAKIA TOUR

Approximately 2 hrs

The easiest way to present the authentic charm and the bohemian spirit of Belgrade in the oldest bars (kafanas) of Belgrade. Includes degustation of quality kinds of rakia and professional presentation. Different flavors of rakia served with appetizer, with emphasis to the taste of rakia. The tour includes the story of the history of rakia and strong alcoholic drinks in the world and in this region, legends about rakia and anecdotes caused by this noble strong alcoholic drink.

BELGRADE SPORT ADVENTURE

Approximately 6 hrs

Bicycle tour on the Danube, Sava and Belgrade Lake - Ada Ciganlija banks, with additional sport activities and recreation: water surfing, rock climbing, bungee jumping, kayaking, football, basketball, inline skating, grass hockey, rugby, paintball, Adventure Park and much more.

NIGHT OF MUSEUMS IN BELGRADE

Approximately 4 hrs

This program presents museums as places in which culture is concentrated and professionally presented. It's based on request of the group, and includes Museum of Ethnography, Museum of Contemporary Art, Nikola Tesla Museum, Museum of Yugoslav History, Museum of Dositej Obradovic and Vuk Karadzic, Museum of Science and Technology, Museum of the National Bank of Serbia, Museum of Fine Arts, Natural History Museum, Military Museum, and much more.
